Can you identify the original members of the "Million Dollar Quartet"? At Sam Phillips' Sun Studios in Memphis Tennessee during the mid-1950s, a gospel quartet was formed which featured four talented young performers: Elvis Presley, Johnny Cash, Jerry Lee Lewis, and Carl (Blue Suede Shoes) Perkins. Following Elvis' passing, Roy Orbison (Elvis' life long friend who also started his career at Sun Records) took Elvis' place and the quartet was resurrected.
